The Iconic Bordeaux Region



BORDEAUX, FRANCE

THE GARONNE, DORDOGNE AND GIRONDE ESTUARY

In the corner of southwestern France, the Garonne and Dordogne rivers merge together to form the Gironde Estuary that naturally divides the famous Bordeaux region into the Left and Right banks. One of the largest controlled wine regions in France, Bordeaux is made up of several sub-regions, each with its own strictly governed appellation, unique climate and terroir. Unlike most wines around the world, the quality of Bordeaux wine is determined by these factors rather than the grape varietal. Bordeaux is acclaimed for its legendary red blends, though white blends from this region also make a big impression. The Left and Right banks of the river have different soil types that bring these exceptional blends to life.

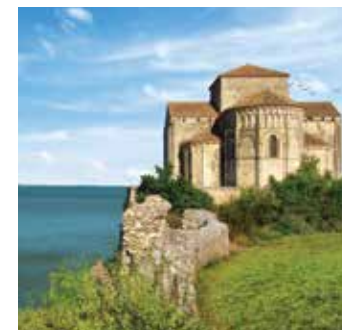
TASTING NOTES

THE LEFT BANK: SAUTERNES AND MÉDOC

The flatter, gravelly lands of the Left Bank embrace the heat of the sun south of the Gironde, giving life to many rich red and sweet white blends like those of the Médoc and Sauternes regions.

THE RIGHT BANK: SAINT-ÉMILION

The limestone and clay soils of the Right Bank are perfect for Merlot, the most popular grape used as a base for blends in Bordeaux. Prestigious appellations like Bourg and Saint-Émilion produce some of the best Merlot-based blends that are combined with Cabernet and other grapes.

LIBOURNE: SAINT-ÉMILION & POMEROL

THE SEINE RIVER

The curvy nature of the Seine River can be disorienting when you're in Paris. Not to worry, just remember to face downstream, so you can tell the Left Bank from the Right. His legacy endures in the form of a prestigious Champagne from Moët & Chandon, which bears his name.

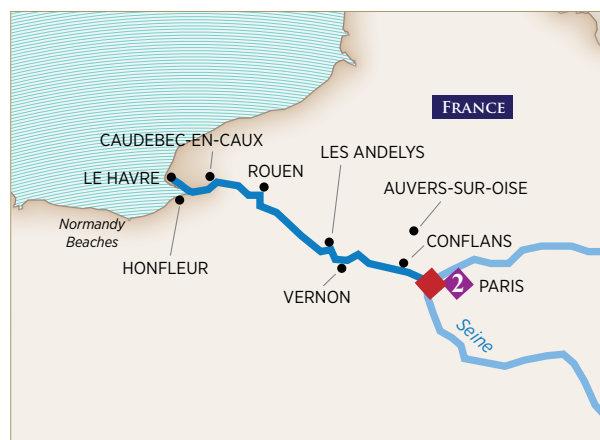

THE RHÔNE RIVER

THE SOUTHERN RHÔNE: GRENACHE

A warmer climate is enjoyed in the Southern Rhône with hot summers and mild winters. The larger sub-region is responsible for nearly 95% of the entire region's wine, including a wide range of everyday whites, rosés and Grenache-based red blends from the Côtes du Rhône appellation. The south also creates a variety of powerful, high-quality reds and whites in areas such as Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

Freiburg is a Black Forest village straight out of a fairytale, with towering cathedrals and lush green hills. Enter from one of two medieval gates—the Martinstor, site of witch burnings in 1599, or the Schwabentor, with its tiny museum—each featuring a charming clock tower. Then, sip a velvety Pinot and become one of the *Vierteleschlotzer*, a name the locals have affectionately given to wine connoisseurs.

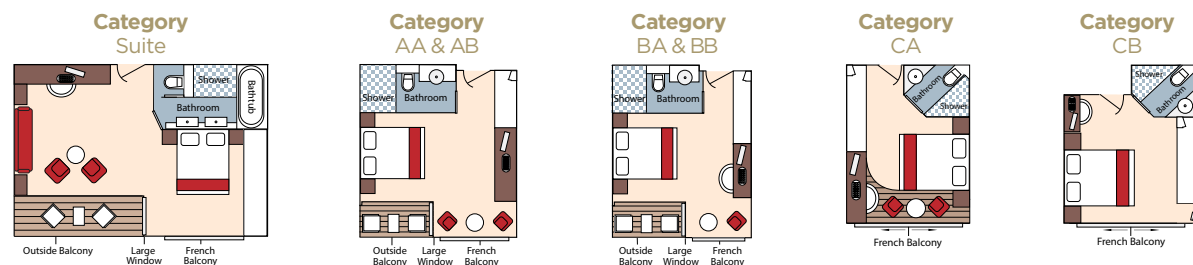

Parties: In these terms and conditions, “you” or “passenger” or “participant” refers to the person booking, purchasing or traveling on the cruise, and to individuals traveling as part of that person’s reservation. “We” or “us” refers to Amadeus Waterways, Inc., a California corporation (“AMA”) and AmaWaterways, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company (“AWL”). AMA offers the travel and enters into these terms and conditions with you pursuant to arrangements made with AWL.

Deposit and Final Payment: To confirm a cruise or cruise & land reservation, we require a deposit of \$400 per person for Europe and Asia itineraries and \$2,400 per person for Africa itineraries on or before the deposit due date indicated on the confirmation. Transoceanic airline flights and packages require an additional deposit of \$350 per person for economy class or \$600 per person for business/first class flights. Certain airline tickets require non-refundable, full payment at the time of reservation. Hotel Extra Nights require a non-refundable deposit of \$50 per stateroom at the time of confirmation of the hotel availability. Final payment is due no later than 90 days before the travel start date.

Cancellation Charges: In the unfortunate event a participant must cancel travel, notice to AmaWaterways must be via email to Res@AmaWaterways.com, which must include a return receipt and read notation, or other writing stating clearly and correctly each guest’s name, ship name, start and end date of the cruise and a brief statement of the reason for cancellation. Other forms of notice are not sufficient. The effective date of the cancellation is the date we receive the written cancellation notice. A change in sailing date, name changes, the substitution of a participant or a reduction in the number of guests in a stateroom are treated as a cancellation in that all applicable cancellation charges apply. In the event that a cruise fare listed, quoted or advertised through any website, printed collateral, reservations person, travel agent or any other source is booked, but is incorrect due to an electronic error, typographical error, human error or any other error causing the fare to be listed, quoted or advertised for an amount not intended by AmaWaterways, AmaWaterways reserves the right to correct the erroneous fare by requesting the passenger to pay the correct fare intended, or by canceling the cruise booking. Airfares, air taxes and air surcharges quoted on your invoice or by a reservation agent are only guaranteed once airfare deposit or full payment is received by AmaWaterways. AmaWaterways reserves the right to increase prices without notice.

Prices Do Not Include: Published prices do not include vessel fuel surcharges; passport and visa fees; baggage fees; travel protection; vaccinations; laundry; additional food and beverages; optional excursions; gratuities or other items or services of a personal nature.

Passport and Visas: A valid passport is required for each participant. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the scheduled return date to your home country. Non-US citizens must consult the appropriate consulates regarding visa and other document requirements. Obtaining required visas and any other required travel documentation, and assuring these are complete and correct in all ways, is the sole responsibility of each participant. We are not in a position to obtain or verify the accuracy or completeness of any participant’s visa or other required documentation and shall not be responsible or liable for delay or missed portion of any part of the itinerary or other problems resulting from the participant lacking the appropriate travel documentation.

Travel Documents: Only after receipt of full payment, travel documents (including airline confirmation information, if applicable) will be sent by regular ground delivery (US & Canada), approximately 3-4 weeks prior

to departure. (Delay in final payment will delay delivery of travel documents.) Expedited delivery may be possible for an additional charge.

FLIGHTS & AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Flight Schedules & Airfares: AmaWaterways offers special airfares based on the flight and seat availability of contracted carriers. We are able to accept a traveler’s choice of preferred air carrier, flight schedule, and some deviations so long as the requests are made at the time of booking the airline reservation. To hold/confirm an airline reservation, the airlines require your full legal name as it appears on your passport. For contract airline fares a **deposit of \$350 per person (economy class tickets) or \$600 per person (business/first-class tickets) is required to secure the flight schedule and quoted price.** Published airfare prices require full payment at the time of reservation. **Once the airfare deposit or full payment is received your airline tickets will be issued** and any changes will be subject to penalty if not cancelled within 24 hours of ticketing. Should the name on your airline reservation not match your passport exactly, your airline reservation will have to be cancelled, full penalties will be assessed and your reservation will have to be recreated subject to market pricing at the time of the new reservation.

Air tickets are Economy class, unless an upgrade is requested, such as upgrading from Economy to Premium Economy, Business or First, and the additional charge for an upgrade is paid, and is issued pursuant to the terms and conditions of the relevant airline(s) upgrade policy. AmaWaterways guarantees this upgrade for long-haul flights, international travel over the ocean or on the longest flight on your itinerary only. For U.S. Domestic flights, Intra-Europe, intra-Asia and intra-Africa flights, upgrades are not guaranteed and will be made only when possible and available.

AmaWaterways is not liable if a Carrier did not accommodate the upgrade due to schedule change, aircraft type change, overbooked flights, strike or flight interruption for any reason. Carriers reserve the right to do all the above at any time and specially before boarding, and as such, AmaWaterways is not responsible. Should there be the need for a refund claim for the difference in the amount, it should be requested through the Carrier.

Airlines require your name to appear on your airline ticket exactly as it appears on your passport. AmaWaterways shall not be responsible or liable for consequences resulting from an incorrect name on airline reservations if the passport name does not match exactly, including denied boarding. AmaWaterways shall not be responsible or liable for costs resulting from airline schedule changes, lost air ticket, delay, disruption or cancelled flight, missed connections, downgrades, denied boarding or voluntarily buying your own tickets without the knowledge and approval of the Carrier. In any of these instances, your claim will have to be with the Carrier and not with AmaWaterways.

Changes: Airline tickets issued by AmaWaterways have restrictions and cannot be reissued, transferred, or exchanged. Any changes made to an airline ticket, including minor name corrections, will incur a minimum of \$350 per ticket change fee for Economy and \$600 per ticket change fee for Business, plus any additional increases in the cost of the airfare. A change

or refund request for tickets purchased through AmaWaterways must be made through us, but may not be possible. For example, some airline tickets are non-refundable. Once a trip commences, only the date of the return flight ticket can be modified for \$350 per ticket change fee for Economy and \$600 per ticket change fee for Business, pending available space, plus any additional increases in the cost of the airfare. Any other changes may result in buying a new ticket. The original return ticket, in part or whole, may not be refundable and no residual value can be used towards another purchase.

Limitation on Special Requests & Frequent Flier Numbers:

As a courtesy, we may try to relay a request for seat assignments, meal requests, frequent flyer numbers, or other special assistance to the airline. Whether we relay a request to an airline, you or your travel agent must always confirm directly with the airline regarding any such requests. To insure you receive proper credit on your frequent flyer account, we recommend you provide your frequent flyer number to the airline at the time of check-in. Our airfare prices use special contract fares that may not allow you to receive credit on your frequent flier account nor may they allow you to use miles to upgrade to a higher class.
